"I have written you quite boldly on some points, as if to remind you of them again, because of the grace God gave me."

- Romans 15:15

2. Is Built Of God's Word!

Romans 15:16

"I have written you quite boldly on some points, as if to remind you of them again, because of the grace God gave me to be a minister of Christ Jesus to the Gentiles with the priestly duty of proclaiming the gospel of God, so that the Gentiles might become an offering acceptable to God, sanctified by the Holy Spirit."

- Romans 15:15-16

3. Is Lived Out For God's Glory!

Romans 15: 17-18

"Therefore I glory in Christ Jesus in my service to God. I will not venture to speak of anything except what Christ has accomplished through me in leading the Gentiles to obey God by what I have said and done."

- Romans 15:18-18

4. Is Empowered By The Holy Spirit!

Romans 15:19

"by the power of signs and miracles, through the power of the Spirit. So from Jerusalem all the way around to Illyricum, I have fully proclaimed the gospel of Christ."

5. Is Planned According To God's Purpose!

Romans 15:20-23

"It has always been my ambition to preach the gospel where Christ was not known, so that I would not be building on someone else's foundation."

6. Is Supported By God's People!

Romans 15: 25-33

"For Macedonia and Achaia were pleased to make a contribution for the poor among the saints in Jerusalem."
