Two Questions To Get Us Thinking!

- *Have you ever thought of giving up on someone?
- * Has anyone ever given up on you?

Because God Is Faithful...

1. He Does Not Give Up!

Romans 11:1-11

“I ask, then, has God rejected His own people, the nation of Israel? Of course not! I myself am an Israelite, a descendant of Abraham and a member of the tribe of Benjamin. No, God has not rejected His own people, whom He chose from the very beginning...”

- Romans 11:1,2a NLT

God did not give up on Israel – He will not give up on you!

2. He Reaches Out To The Lost!

Romans 11:11-17

“Did God’s people stumble and fall beyond recovery? Of course not! They were disobedient, so God made salvation available to the Gentiles. But He wanted His own people to become jealous and claim it for themselves.”

- Romans 11:11 NLT

“When seeing what God has done for you...
Others will want what God can do for them!”

3. He Warns Us About Unbelief and Pride!

Romans 11:18-25

“Notice how God is both kind and severe. He is severe toward those who disobeyed, but kind to you if you continue to trust in His kindness. But if you stop trusting, you also will be cut off.”

- Romans 11:22 NLT

“I want you to understand this mystery, dear brothers and sisters, so that you will not feel proud about yourselves. Some of the people of Israel have hard hearts, but this will last only until the full number of Gentiles comes to Christ.”

- Romans 11:25 NLT

Unbelief – A rejection of Jesus.

Pride – A false understanding of what we can do or attain.

4. His Plans Will Always Be Accomplished!

Romans 11:25-32

“...but this will last only until the full number of Gentiles comes to Christ.²⁶ And so all Israel will be saved...”

- Romans 11:25b,26a NLT

5. We Are Wise If We Honor and Obey Him!

Romans 11:33-36

“For everything comes from Him and exists by His power and is intended for His glory. All glory to Him forever! Amen.”

- Romans 11:36 NLT
