1. I Must Be Committed To Change!

“Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God—this is your spiritual act of worship.”

- Romans 12:1 NIV

1. Voluntary!
2. Practical!
3. Complete!
4. Daily!

2. I Must Be Willing To Stand Firm Against Competing Desires!

“Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.”

- Romans 12:2 NIV

3. I Must Be Committed To The Process Of Transformation!

“Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.”

Three Ways To Transform Your Mind!

1. Read and think about God’s Word.!

“Such things were written in the Scriptures long ago to teach us. And the Scriptures give us hope and encouragement as we wait patiently for God’s promises to be fulfilled.”

2. Talk to others to understand how to apply God’s word!

“But encourage one another daily, as long as it is called Today, so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness.”

- Hebrews 3:13

3. Listen to material that will encourage you to change!

“Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.”
